Sheep shearing is physically demanding and requires bending and lifting the equivalent of 50 lbs. or more. **Participants take part in this training at their own risk.** It is recommended participants engage in, at a mini-

mum, gentle stretching daily leading up to this introductory class. People with chronic spinal pain or injury are strongly discouraged from participating in the live animal handling portion of this school.
